I oppose the mask mandate. I currently live in PG County, but my children attend a private school in Charles County and my husband works in Charles County and I do the vast majority of my shopping and leisure activities in Charles County; however, during the times of the mask mandates, my shopping and activity in Charles County decreased with an increased interest in online shopping and/or traveling to jurisdictions without a mask mandate. Attendance at activities such as seeing movies in movie theatres in Charles County decreased due to the mask mandate. My views on the mask mandate are largely based on research. I have a Master's of Public Health degree with a concentration in Epidemiology/Biostatistics.
