I am opposed to the adoption of any Resolution Requiring the use of Masks (Face Coverings) as a Health Ordinance in Charles County. I am extremely disheartened by the continued use of County resources directed to the imposition of masks on private citizens. I am a born and bred Charles County resident, living here my entire life. Here, my husband has a business and we are raising our family. However, we no longer shop, conduct business, or go to restaurants in this county. My family has even changed our place of worship to a church in St. Mary's. I readily expend more time and money to do business outside of the county where masks are not mandated and the people around me respect my personal decision to forego a mask. For my family, we have found masks to not be just a nuisance, but also a health risk that we are not willing to take. We have many children who are at a vulnerable age where their body and minds are still growing. Cognitive function is affected by the amount of oxygen (or lack thereof) and carbon dioxide (or excess thereof) that one's body receives. The long-term cognitive function health risks related to prolonged use of masks in children for extended periods of time are completely unknown and have not been studied. My children's health has been adversely affected by the constant forced use of masks. My children would be classified as healthy, active children, in the lower percentiles for weight, not considered obese. Not a single one has had underlying health complications, such as asthma, that could be a catalyst for a bona fide medical exemption. However, all of my children have shown signs of oxygen depletion or carbon monoxide poisoning, such as increases in headaches / migraines, dizziness, confusion / loss of the ability to focus, turning pale / about to pass out,

increased irritability, and emotion outbreaks. These health complications only arise after prolonged mask usage. I respectfully ask that you withdraw it or vote NO.
