I work for my family's small business that has been operating in this county for over 40 years. A majority my and my family's time is spent at work. My parents work here, my wife works here, our 2 year old son comes to work with us, and my 4 year old daughter comes here when she is picked up from school. I obtained my wear and carry permit in 2020, and I have been legally carrying my fire arm for coming up on three years. If you were to pass Bill 2022-14 you would be effectively stripping me of my permit and my right to defend my family and business. We work right across the street from the CC Health Department and are within the proposed 100 yard restriction. You would be making me into a criminal if I were to come to our place of business with the same tool that I have been carrying with me for the last three years. Obviously I am opposed to this overreach. This would be an unjust action on your part and would impact those of us who have gone through the many hoops required to obtain our wear and carry permit. I had to pay for and go through 16 hours of training, was finger printed twice (at my expense), and go through a background check for every firearm purchase that I have made. I also have to re-take the training this year as my permit will expire in April. I will have to go through this similar process (at my own expense) all over again. This

proposition will not keep us safer, it will just be another way our elitist government can strip the rights that are protected by Constitution from the average citizen. I followed the law that's been in place; why am I being punished for it?
