**Comment**

Bill is too broad in scope and would inappropriately criminalize otherwise legal activities. 100 yards (300 ft) enforcement area from any Charles County ... operated ... grounds could be construed to include the entirety of passing public roadways or ANY county right of ways. The "operated grounds" could also include areas of water, sanitary, storm or other easements on private property thereby making the property owners criminals in the own house. Considering that there are dozens, if not hundreds, of buildings owned or operated by Charles County Government, there should include a provision that ALL such buildings should be clearly and blatantly marked with signs or notice visible and legible from at least 150 yards (450 ft) away. I enter this comment as a member of the public that frequently travels roadways within Charles County that would be affected by this bill.
