I would like to express my disapproval of the gun ban as currently proposed. As a wear and carry permit holder I have no problem with a ban inside of a county building for security and providing a safe work environment. I believe the ban of 100 yards; the length of a football field, is excessive, poorly thought out and a governmental overreach.
