POSSESSION OF A WEAPON OR FIREARM IS PERMISSIBLE 16 WITHIN 100 YARDS OF IN A BUILDING OWNED OR OPERATED BY CHARLES COUNTY GOVERNMENT OR THE BOARD OF CHARLES COUNTY COMMISSIONERS 17 18 IF THE PERSON IN POSSESSION IS: 19 (1) AN ACTIVE SWORN LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER OR ACTIVE CHARLES 20 COUNTY CORRECTIONAL OFFICER; OR 21 22 23 (2) AN ON-DUTY EMPLOYEE OF A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY AUTHORIZED BY THE AGENCY TO POSSESS FIREARMS WHILE ON-DUTY OR WHOSE DUTY 24 ASSIGNMENT INVOLVES THE POSSESSION OF FIREARMS; OR 25 26 27 (3) A SPECIAL POLICE OFFICER EMPLOYED BY CHARLES COUNTY GOVERNMENT 28 WITH A VALID GOVERNMENT ISSUED PERMIT TO CARRY A WEAPON OR 29 FIREARM; OR 30 31 (43) ACTIVE DUTY MILITARY PERSONNEL ENGAGED IN THE PERFORMANCE OF 32 THEIR OFFICIAL EMPLOYMENT DUTIES; OR 33 34 (54) A MEMBER OF THE BOARD OF CHARLES COUNTY COMMISSIONERS. 35 (D) PROOF OF AUTHORITY TO CARRY A WEAPON OR FIREARM. THE CHIEF OF 36 37 CENTRAL SERVICES FOR CHARLES COUNTY GOVERNMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REQUIRE PROOF OF A VALID GOVERNMENT ISSUED PERMIT OR OTHER 38 GRANTING AUTHORITY FOR ANY PERSON CLAIMING AN EXEMPTION UNDER 39 PART C (1), (2), (3), (4) OR (54) OF THIS SECTION. FAILURE TO PROVIDE PROOF 40 WHEN REQUESTED SHALL RESULT IN REFUSAL TO ALLOW THE WEAPON OR 41 42 FIREARM WITHIN 100 YARDS OFIN A BUILDING OWNED OR OPERATED BY CHARLES COUNTY GOVERNMENT OR THE BOARD OF CHARLES COUNTY 43
