I am against the proposed bill. This is an infringement on Charles County citizen's 2nd amendment rights. The language in the bill calling for a 100 yard buffer will make it impossible for citizens who have legally obtained a carry permit to simply pass county buildings on the street. Anyone who lives next to a county building will also be in violation.
