Villages of Wooded Glen and Piney Reach Master Plan

WHAT is this Letter of Notification all about?

- This letter of notification is being sent from St. Charles Community LLC to owners of property in and around the Villages of Wooded Glen and Piney Reach so they are aware of requested changes to the Master Plan affecting those neighborhoods. This letter of notification is for informational purposes only so that residents are aware of the opportunities to participate in the public process.
- The St. Charles Planned Unit Development (PUD) consists of five (5) “Villages”, including Wooded Glen and Piney Reach Villages. Each of the 5 Villages is subject to a Master Plan that guides land uses and development within those Villages. The Villages of Wooded Glen & Piney Reach have been, and continue to be, considered on one Master Plan (which can be found at: <https://bit.ly/Docket90Amendment>)
- This amendment would change the master plan that is written for the neighborhoods (“villages”) of Wooded Glen and Piney Reach, which are located in St. Charles.
- The amendment requests three changes to the Master Plan:
 1. *Change in school location:* The plan currently has an elementary school and a middle school indicated in Wooded Glen Neighborhood #3 (Highlands Neighborhood) off St. Charles Parkway. This amendment would change the site of the middle school to Piney Reach Neighborhood #2 off Piney Church Road. The elementary school would remain within Wooded Glen Neighborhood #3.
 2. *Change in 85% Rule:* The amendment also proposes to waive the “85% Rule” as it applies to the Villages of Piney Reach Neighborhood #3. The “85% rule” states that no residential construction of any kind shall begin in the Village of Piney Reach until 85% of all residential construction has been completed in the Village of Wooded Glen. This change would allow residential construction to occur in the neighborhood the Village of Piney Reach Neighborhood 3 prior to completion of 85% of the construction in the Village of Wooded Glen. Currently, Wooded Glen is approximately 29% complete.
 3. *Elimination of Buffer Remediation Plan:* In 2018, Charles County requested that St. Charles Community LLC (the developer/applicant) create a Buffer Remediation Plan that improved a vegetated buffer (an area of trees and other vegetation that provides a screen to block the view of the development from the roadway) along MD 488 (La Plata Road). At this time, trees and other vegetation have regrown and naturally re-established the buffer; therefore, the plan for remediation (improvement) does not need to be implemented because the improvements occurred naturally.

WHY is this on the Agenda for the Board of County Commissioners?

- The Charles County Code requires changes to the Master Plans for development to be presented for public input and hearing before the Planning Commission and the County Commissioners.

WHO does this amendment affect?

- This affects residents in the Villages of Wooded Glen and Piney Reach neighborhoods and other surrounding neighborhoods.

WHEN is this amendment being discussed and voted on, & when would it possibly take effect?

- This amendment will have a public hearing on Tuesday, March 28 (in-person) and March 29 (virtually), 2023.
- The Board of Charles County Commissioners may vote to accept the amendments at the close of the public hearing, or they may choose to schedule a final vote for a future meeting.

Individuals or representatives of groups wishing to make oral or written comments are encouraged to attend the hearing and can submit comments in the following ways:

- **Comment In-person:** Speaker sign-up will begin 30 minutes prior to the hearing at the Charles County Government Building (200 Baltimore Street, La Plata) on March 28, 2023 and will end at the commencement of the hearing.
- **Comment Virtually:** Call 240-776-6709 between 8:00 a.m. on March 28, 2023 to 4:00 p.m. on March 29, 2023 to register to speak. Once registered, individuals will receive a virtual link to join the meeting. Virtual public comments will be heard between 6:00-9:00pm on March 29th. If you are not available to speak when you are called, we have the right to move on to the next caller. Each speaker will be allotted three minutes to speak.
- **Provide Written or Voicemail Comments:** Written or voicemail comments may be submitted in lieu of oral testimony, or to expand upon oral testimony, and will be accepted starting at 8:00 a.m. on Friday, March 10, 2023, and end at 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, March 29, 2023:
