For the purpose of including hazmat technician and mobile integrated healthcare nurse as covered employees for voluntary collective bargaining with Charles County Government in accordance with Title 4, Subtitle 5, of the Annotated Code of Maryland, Labor and Employment Article.

4 **TECHNICIAN, AND MOBILE INTEGRATED HEALTHCARE NURSE** (hereinafter
5 "covered employees").

9 **FORTY-FIVE (45) CALENDAR DAYS AFTER IT BECOMES LAW.**




