1	A. This article applies to all full-time merit system employees in the Emergency Medical
2	Services Division of the Charles County Department of Emergency Services who hold the
3	following ranks: Lieutenant, paramedic, [and] emergency medical technician, HAZMAT
4	TECHNICIAN, AND MOBILE INTEGRATED HEALTHCARE NURSE (hereinafter
5	"covered employees").
