Safety Tips for You and Others:

- Always carry a first-aid kit and a cell phone. Keep means of transportation readily available.
- Keep the number of vehicles to a minimum and park them clear of roadways.
- Wear a safety vest, light colored clothing, long sleeves, gloves, and sturdy-soled footwear.
- Proper adult supervision is required for volunteers under 18 years old.
- Only work during daylight hours and never work during peak travel times.
- Avoid inclement weather.
- Face oncoming traffic.
- Do not enter the traveled part of the roadway.
- Do not pick up items from bridges, overpasses, or tunnels.
- Stay clear of construction.
- Do not remove hazardous materials; advise Charles County Sheriff's Office immediately, 301-932-2222.
- Avoid overexertion and exhaustion.
- Horseplay, alcohol, and narcotics are strictly prohibited.
- Use your best judgment when confronted with an obstacle not addressed here.
