Then maybe the stores would be better patronized. Also, it's difficult to stay aware of initiatives in the area. I didn't know about the Maryland Airport and its impact on our air quality. I didn't know that people were mobilizing to stop the airport's expansion. I didn't know about indigenous heritage initiatives. I didn't even know about the Bryans Road Sub-Area Plan until I found out by chance.
