

- 1. ALL PLUGS SHALL BE UTILIZED TO ISOLATE ALL DISCHARGE INTO CHARLES COUNTY'S SEWER SYSTEM. PLUGS SHALL BE UTILIZED FOR ALL SEWAGE BY PASS OPERATIONS.
- 2. ALL PLUGS SHALL BE PLACED IN THE UPSTREAM LINE OF THE MANHOLE AND SHALL BE SECURED WITH A STEEL CHAIN AND TIED TO A 4" X 4" WOOD TO PREVENT IT FROM GOING DOWN THE LINE.
- 3. ALL PLUGS SHALL BE BRACED AS SHOWN WITH PRESSURE TREATED 2" X 4" WOOD AND ASSEMBLED USING 16 PENNY HOT DIPPPED GALVANIZED FASTNERS. PLUG PLATE SHALL BE 1" LONGER THAN THE CORED OPENING DIAMETER IN THE MANHOLE AND REST FIRMLY AGAINST PLUG.
- 4. DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE THE TIMING AND PLACEMENT OF ALL PLUGS WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND GROWTH MANAGEMENT, CODES, PERMITS, AND INSPECTION SERVICES (PGM/CPIS) INSPECTOR. THE DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR PUMPING OUT ANY MANHOLE/MAIN CONTAINING WATER.
- 5. UPON COMPLETION OF ALL OR PORTION OF THE SEWER SYSTEM AND UPON ACCEPTANCE (SUBSTANTIAL COMPLETION) BY PGM/CPIS AND PUBLIC WORKS UTILITIES, THE DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE PGM/CPIS INSPECTOR TO COORDINATE THE REMOVAL OF THE PLUG(S).
