PROCLAMATION 2023-13

Social Work Month

WHEREAS, the 2023 Social Work Month theme, "Social Work Breaks Barriers" supports the hard work that social workers do daily to help breakdown barriers that prevent people from living more fulfilled and enriched lives; they work on the individual level helping people overcome personal crisis like food insecurity, lack of affordable housing or limited access to good healthcare;
