WHEREAS, Resource Parents improve the well-being of children and youth in foster care through advocacy and at times assisting with a successful transition into adulthood; and

WHEREAS, Resource Parents, with support and compassion, promote permanency for children and youth by working with birthparents and their extended families to ensure children maintain long lasting connections in Charles County; and

WHEREAS, we honor Resource Parents and their ongoing efforts with community partners to promote safety, permanency and well-being for Charles County's children and youth in foster care.
