PROCLAMATION 2021-40

NATIONAL HISPANIC HERITAGE MONTH

WHEREAS, each year, Americans observe National Hispanic Heritage Month from September 15 to October 15, by celebrating the contributions of American citizens whose ancestors came from Spain, Mexico, the Caribbean, Central America and South America; and

WHEREAS, Hispanic-American men and women embody the American values of devotion to faith and family, hard work, and patriotism through their contributions as leaders, innovators, entrepreneurs, and members of our Armed Forces; and

WHEREAS, Charles County celebrates the accomplishments of the 9,754 Hispanic American citizens who live in our County; and

WHEREAS, the 2021 Hispanic Heritage month theme: "Esperanza: A Celebration of Hispanic Heritage and Hope," invites all to reflect on Hispanic American's service and contributions to the history of our County and our Nation.
