Briefing and Tour: Naval Support Facility Indian Head

Mr. Ashley Johnson, Technical Director, Naval Surface Warfare Center Indian Head EOD Technology Division, provided the Commissioners and Leaders from the Military Alliance Council and the Charles County Chamber of Commerce, an overview of the mission of Indian Head EOD Technology Division. Mr. Johnson then explained the proposed relocation of Chemical, Biological, and Radiological Defense Division from Naval Support Facility Dahlgren to Naval Support Facility Indian Head. The discussion focused on the potential economic impact it would have for the County and ways the Naval Support Facility Indian Head could build partnerships with the County and businesses in order recruit, train and retain staff at this location. He stressed the importance of Energetics and need to keep it in the forefront of the Department of Defense and the Navy.
