Thank you for your time this evening.

My husband and I reside on Community Drive in the subdivision of Meadowland in Waldorf, MD. Our subdivision was built in the early 90s. Community Drive is owned by the County. (off Route228 near intersection of Middleton Road) I am the Board President of the Meadowland HOA.

Here is our concern and request:

Charles County Roads are presently performing road work this week on Community Drive (they started Monday.)

We were informed yesterday by the County Roads Project manager they only have authorization to do patchwork on some of the cracks and an overlay. Versus fixing all stress cracks and paving all of the street with new asphalt.

Due to the wear and tear and damage we were under the impression that the County was going to repair all cracks in the road, remove the old asphault and pave new asphalt. Versus just patchwork and overlay.

We take seriously our property values in Meadowland and the aesthetics of our community. As you can understand a road with various patchwork is not attractive. Upon viewing the work so far there are now large black patches sporadically throughout our community.

Also, the overlay is only a temporary fix and the other cracks they will not repair will only get

worse. Once the overlay is poured the cracks can still be visible.

We are kindly asking that County Roads workers have permission to repair and pave all of Community Drive. (versus only patchwork and overlay.) We are willing to wait until the Summer if needed due to scheduling.

We understand this may be a budget issue. This issue is also not the fault of County Road workers themselves. They have been very helpful and are working hard.

Again, please approve County Roads to repair and pave all of Community Drive. We appreciate your time and attention to this.
