

## NOTES:

- 1. THE DIMENSIONS SHOWN HERE ARE TYPICAL AND MAY BE MODIFIED IN SPECIFIC SITUATIONS BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND GROWTH MANAGEMENT.
- 2. TREES ARE TO BE LOCATED WITH THE FOLLOWING MINIMUM CLEARANCES.
  - A. 5' FROM WATER METER OR CURB BOX.
  - B. 5' FROM GAS BOX.
  - C. 5' FROM INLET OR MANHOLE.
  - D. 10' FROM FIRE HYDRANT.
  - E. 15' FROM STREET LIGHT.
  - F. 1' INSIDE RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE WHERE CURB AND GUTTER; 11' OUTSIDE RIGHT-OF-WAY WHERE NO CURB.
- 3. MINOR TREE SPACING 30' ON CENTER MINIMUM.
- 4. MAJOR TREE SPACING 50' ON CENTER MINIMUM.
- 5. SHADE TREES TO BE 1 1/2" MINIMUM CALIPER AND 10' MINIMUM HEIGHT.
- 6. FLOWERING TREES TO BE 3/4" MINIMUM CALIPER AND 6' MINIMUM HEIGHT.
- 7. SPECIES TO BE AS APPROVED BY CHARLES COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND GROWTH MANAGEMENT.
- 8. SEE DETAILS NO. R/2.42 AND R/2.43 FOR PLANTING DETAILS.
- 9. NO TREE IS PERMITTED IF GREEN SPACE IS LESS THAN 6'. THIS DISTANCE IS MEASURED BETWEEN THE FLOW LINE OF CURB AND GUTTER AND NEAR EDGE OF SIDEWALK,
