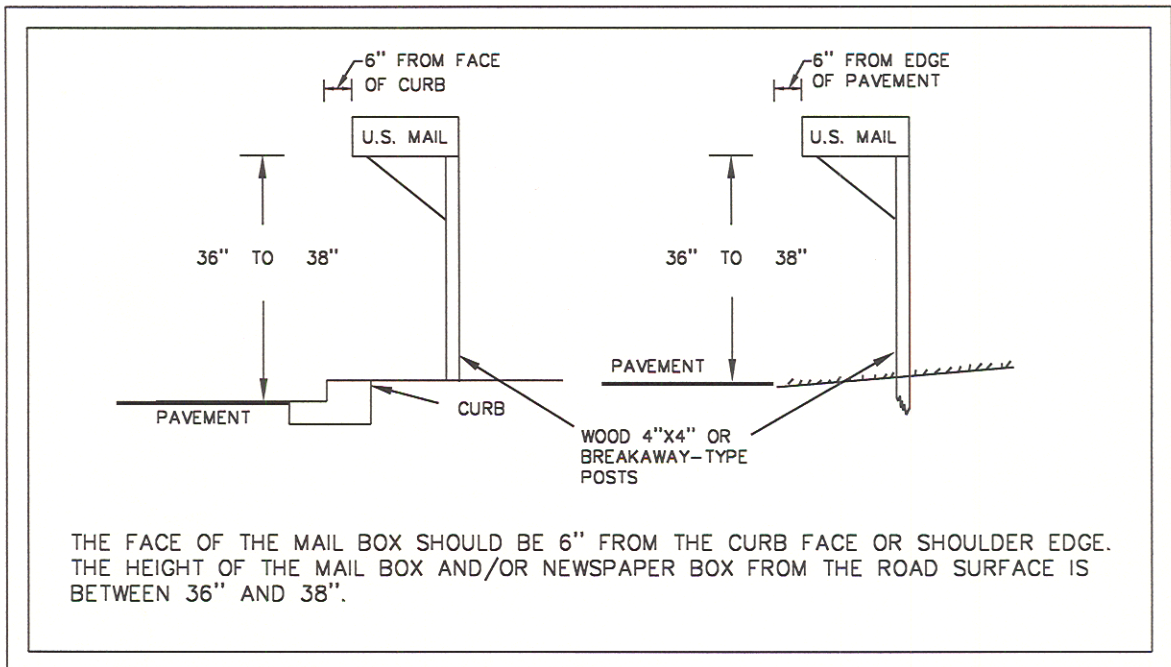


COUNTY REGULATIONS AND THE CHARLES COUNTY ROAD ORDINANCE PROHIBITS ANY PRIVATELY OWNED PERMANENT OR SEMI-PERMANENT STRUCTURES WITHIN THE ROAD RIGHTS-OF-WAY SUCH AS:

- FENCES
- BASKETBALL HOOPS
- SIGNS
- GAZEBOS
- ETC.

THE ONLY EXCEPTION IS A REGULATION U.S. MAIL BOX AND/OR NEWSPAPER BOX AS INDICATED BELOW.



TO AVOID THE COST AND AGGRAVATION OF REMOVING STRUCTURES PLACED WITHIN THE ROAD RIGHTS-OF-WAY, PLEASE CONTACT THE PUBLIC FACILITIES DEPARTMENT AT (301)932-3450 PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION TO DETERMINE THE RIGHT-OF-WAY WIDTH.

ADHERENCE TO THESE RULES WILL GREATLY REDUCE LIABILITY AND WILL ASSIST IN ASSURING THE SAFETY OF PEDESTRIANS AND VEHICLES.
