Dear Members of the Charter Review Commission:

The Association of Local Government Auditors (ALGA) recently learned that your Charter Review Commission has been actively evaluating Charles County's Charter to make government more effective and better serve your residents and taxpayers. ALGA encourages you to consider an independent performance audit function for the County of Charles County as part of your Charter review.

An independent performance audit function, operating under applicable auditing standards, plays a key role in effective, equitable governance and public accountability. An independent audit function also provides assurance to elected officials, residents, and management that resources are protected by strong management controls and practices; reports on the results and outcomes of programs and services; and helps ensure compliance with laws, policies and procedures.
