Summary of Planning Commission Decisions

July 15, 2024

Item: 7.a Critical Area Intrafamily Transfer Change in Circumstance for Denison Subdivision Lot 4

The Planning Commission concurred that there was a change in circumstance for an exception to Interfamily Transfer provision of 297-132 (B)(5) of the Charles County Zoning Ordinance.

Factors considered in reaching the decision were as follows:

- The detailed analysis provided in the Staff Report.
- The Applicant's representative written justification which included an Affidavit from the prior owner confirming that:
 - The prior owner has not resided in Charles County for more than five years.
