

WHEREAS, recognizing that over forty percent of households are living in a state of persistent financial insecurity with almost no savings to cover emergencies or plan for the future, it is imperative that we promote financial education to assist individuals with their personal finances and understand the serious consequences that result from poor money management; and

WHEREAS, several organizations within Charles County provide services aimed at alleviating the causes and conditions financial vulnerability, and provide educational programming as a part of National Financial Literacy Month, to include Southern Maryland CASH (Creating Assets, Savings, and Hope) Coalition, and the University of Maryland Extension Charles County; and
