WHEREAS, the Salvation Army National Capital Area Command, along with its volunteers, donors, business and government partners, serve the local community in accordance with its mission, "to meet human needs without discrimination."

NOW, THEREFORE, WE, THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CHARLES COUNTY,

MARYLAND do hereby proclaim May 13 - 19, 2024, as National Salvation Army Week in Charles County to observe this occasion by recognizing the service and dedication of The Salvation Army to improving the lives of Charles County Residents and all citizens.
