## **PROCLAMATION 2024-69**

## **CONSTITUTION WEEK**

WHEREAS, September 17, 2024 marks the two hundred and thirty-seventh anniversary of the drafting of the Constitution of the United States of America by the Constitutional Convention; and

WHEREAS, celebration of the Constitution was started when the Daughters of the American Revolution petitioned Congress in 1955 to aside September 17-23 for the observance of Constitution Week and this observance week was signed into public law on August 2, 1956; and

WHEREAS, Constitution Week is the commemoration of America's most important document. The Constitution is celebrated annually to commemorate its history, importance, and bring attention to how it serves still today; and

WHEREAS: it is fitting and proper to accord official recognition to this magnificent document and its memorable anniversary; and to the patriotic celebrations which will commemorate the occasion; and

WHEREAS, the aims of celebrating Constitution Week are to emphasize citizens' responsibilities for protecting and defending the Constitution and to inform people that it is the basis for America's great heritage and foundation for our way of life; and

NOW, THEREFORE, WE, THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CHARLES COUNTY, MARYLAND, do hereby proclaim the week of September 17-23, 2024 as CONSTITUTION WEEK in Charles County, and ask all people to reaffirm the ideals the Framers of the constitution had in 1787 by vigilantly protecting the freedoms guaranteed to us through this guardian of our liberties, remembering that lost rights may never be regained.
