- Director Dickerson informed the Board that there are 7 polling sites remaining to be evaluated. Board members all selected sites to evaluate.
- Director Dickerson reminded the Board that swearing-in will take place on October 10, 2024 at 10 a.m.
- Director Dickerson announced to the Board that Mail-In 1 Early Canvass will be on October 15, 2024 at 10 a.m. and that the Public Demonstration will take place on October 18, 2024 at 10 a.m.
