RESOLVED, that upon taking office every officer will take an Oath of Office, which will be administered by the Clerk to the County Commissioners, or the Clerk's designee.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of the Oath of Office Certificate is attached hereto and made a part hereof.
