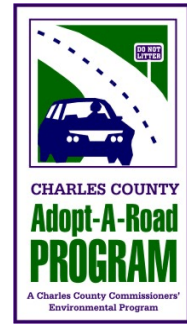




Charles County Adopt-A-Road Safety Procedures



In case of an emergency, carry a first-aid kit at all times and keep means of transportation readily available. A cellular phone is also strongly suggested.

Suggestions for cleanup sessions include wearing light colored clothing, long sleeves, gloves, and sturdy-soled footwear.

In order to protect yourself and others:



- Horseplay, alcohol, and narcotics are strictly prohibited!
- Keep the number of vehicles to a minimum and park them clear of roadways.
- Only work during daylight hours and never during peak travel times.
- Always provide proper adult supervision with youths.
- Face oncoming traffic.
- Avoid inclement weather.
- Avoid overexertion and exhaustion.
- Do not remove hazardous substances, advise Environmental Health immediately.
- Do not pick up items on bridges, tunnels, and overpasses.
- Stay clear from any type of construction.
- Please do not enter the traveled part of the roadway.
- Wear safety vests at all times
