Of Aging	Community Options Waiver, CFC, CPAS	Community Options Waiver, CFC, CPAS	The Community Options Waiver is open to qualified disabled persons of all ages with long term care needs, including children. The purpose of the CO Waiver is to provide long term care via home & community based services to disabled persons who would otherwise warrant placement in a skilled nursing facility. The Waiver allows services that are typically covered by Medicaid only in a nursing facility to be provided to eligible persons in their own homes or in assisted living facilities. Eligible persons must meet both financial and medical criteria to participate and are periodically reevaluated to determine ongoing eligibility. Administration of the Medicaid Waiver requires comprehensive case management and individualized coordination of community-based care services. The Community Options Waiver operates as a fee-for-service program, where associated personnel must track allowable case management activities and submit a monthly invoice for billable hours. Approved billable hours are subsequently reimbursed by the State at a fixed rate established by Medicaid and administered by DHMH.
