### Comment

If this amendment to the Comprehensive Plan is approved, the subsequent rezoning of a targeted ecological area to industrial use would further damage one of the Bay's best tributaries when it is teetering at the threshold for irreversible damage. According to Charles County's own GIS-based computations in its 2016 Comprehensive Plan, 9.8% of the watershed is already covered by impervious surface. The increased siltation which limits the ability to look down and see a clear view is like your vision changing from 20/20 to 20/60. I have noticed this the past few years paddling on my favorite, Mattawoman Creek. It is evidence of the Creek slowly finding a new flow from upstream development and stormwater runoff.
