My 95 year old father-in-law lives in the development that will be served with the new proposed water line. The community has been working with Planning and Growth Management to get this water system installed for a very long time. I don't recall exactly how long, I believe it started in 2014, 7 years ago. There have been multiple petitions signed by the community, multiple promises by the County Planning and Growth department, a couple of briefings to the Commissioners, and several public meetings such as this. It seems as though it is impossible to get all the tasks done, blocks checked, approvals given to bring this project to completion. Just last May the Community was promised that construction would start very soon, now we need a hearing and some other things done before we can get to construction. This is just the latest in a string of commitments made by the County staff that all have not been met. The project is desperately needed by the community.
