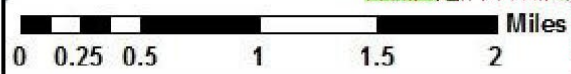
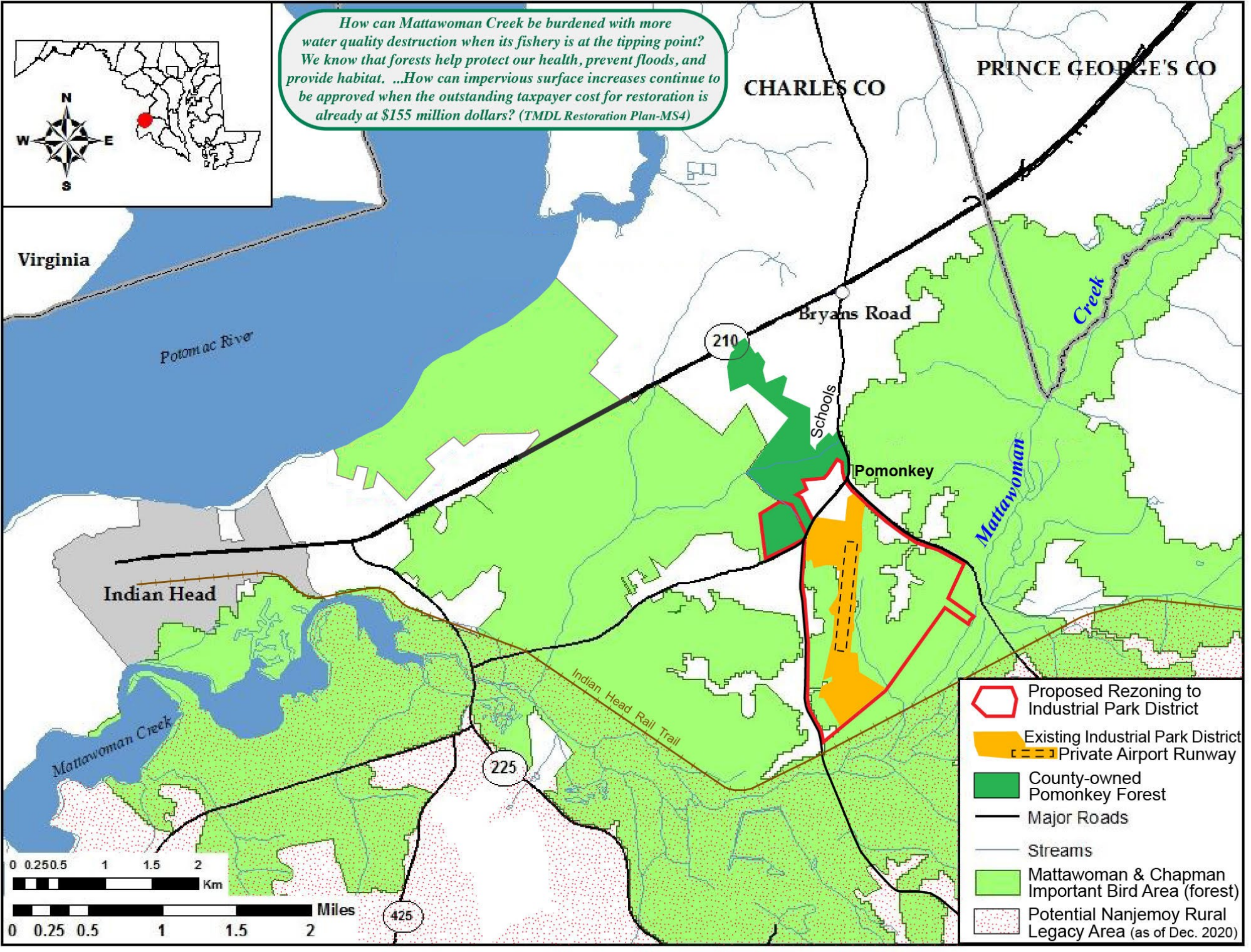


Protect Mattawoman Biodiversity -- STOP Airport Expansion
