- 50% received May 19, 2021 and 50% on June 9, 2022
- Require that payments from the Fiscal Recovery Funds be used only to cover costs incurred by local government by December 31, 2024
- A recipient must return any funds not obligated by <u>December 31, 2024</u>, and any funds not expended to cover such obligations by <u>December 31, 2026</u> (on-line and working)
- Surface Transportation projects must be completed by September 30, 2026
